The Middle Tennessee Daffodil Society Show was held at Cheekwood Estate and Gardens in Nashville TN on March 23 and 24, 2019. The show had 511 stems, 303 entries, 26 exhibitors, 27 photographs by 7 photographers and 14 Artistic Design entries by 6 exhibitors. A new photography exhibitor, Dana Marshall, won the Wells Knierim ribbon. Anne Owen won the Best in Show for Design. Susan Basham and Michael & Lisa Kuduk tied for the Silver Ribbon for the most blue ribbons in the show.
